The following proposal is aimed to improve NAFL Rosters.


### Proposal A – Roster Size – Keep COVID -19 Roster Sizes (Select One) – Option A Passed

Due to the uncertainty of COVID-19 roster sizes were increased temporary so owners are asked if we should make the rule permanent.

- A) Make permanent the COVID-19 Roster size of 26 players, thereby adding two additional offensive players on a roster. The number of rounds in the draft will increase by 2 rounds so the total number of rounds will be 26 rounds.
- B) **Keep rosters at their PRE-COVID size of 24 players.** The number of rounds in the draft will be 24 rounds.

The following proposals are aimed to improve competition.


# Proposal B – Increase the NAFL schedule (Select One) Option A Passed

The following proposals are aimed in improving league finances


### <u>Proposal C – Update League Finances (Select One)</u> Option B Passed


